## IREA Announces Energy Assistance Month

***The Association will provide up to \$75,000 in matching funds to aid those in need.***

Intermountain Rural Electric Association has established a Low-Income Energy Assistance program to support families that need help paying their electric bills. Your November electric bill will contain a form which gives you an opportunity to make a monthly contribution to assist those in need. You may donate whatever you wish: \$5, \$10, \$20 or more. This amount is added to your monthly electric bill until you notify us to discontinue the contribution.

The IREA Board of Directors has determined that, each year, the Association will match member-donated funds with funds from our general donations account, up to \$75,000. The funds will be given to Energy Outreach Colorado, the state's non-profit energy assistance agency, to assist hundreds of IREA consumers who need help paying their electric bills.

Thanks to hundreds of our members who contributed to the program last year, nearly 300 IREA families, seniors, and individuals with special health needs received energy assistance from Energy Outreach Colorado.
